• **LEED EQ Credit 4.1** – Products that have VOC (Volatile Organic Compound) contents that are less than the limit of the State of California's South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) Rule #1168, amended January 19, 2010. The current VOC limit for Architectural Sealants is 250 grams per liter and this category refers to any sealant that can be applied to stationary structures, including mobile homes, and their appurtenances, for example, hand railings, cabinets, bathroom and kitchen fixtures, fences, rain gutters and downspouts, and windows.
